Glossary of Terms (11th Edition)

- Alba:** The Ancient Name for the Nation of Scotland/Caledonia as chosen by the People of that Nation for defining their Territory Claim as part of the Albion Council Co-Op.
- Alba Council:** The Council as established on 7th December 2024 in Dalbeattie Community Hall, Dalbeattie, Scotland, Alba with Manifesto and Code of Conduct for Members.
- Alba Council Co-Op:** The Co-Op as established on 7th December 2024 in Dalbeattie Community Hall, Dalbeattie, Scotland, Alba.
- Albion:** An Ancient Name for **Engleland/England**
- Albion Council:** The Council with equal number of representatives from Wales (**Cymru**), Ireland (**Éire**) Scotland (**Alba**) and England (**Engleland**) as established in Knowle, Solihull Birmingham on 15th June 2024 with Manifesto and Code of Conduct for Members.
- Albion Council Co-Op:** The Co-Op as established in Knowle, Solihull, Birmingham on 15th June 2024.
- Albion Region:** The combined Territorial Regions of **Engleland , Kernow, Éire, Alba & Cymru**, inclusive of the Land and Territorial Waters of **Engleland , Kernow, Éire, Alba & Cymru**.
- Albion Shield:** The Shield as created by, Formally Endorsed and Adopted by, the IRB on 14th April 2023, with IRB Copy-Right Copy-Claim, and Adopted by ERB on 15th April 2023, and Adopted by the Albion Council on 15th June 2024, as the correction of the Crown Shield of 1542 subsequently amended by IRB Volition in 1953, for the Albion Region.
- Alien:** A Male or Female irrespective of age not born in Ireland and who is resident in Ireland and who does not have at least one parent that was born in Ireland.
- Alien Government:** A Government Organisation or Corporation that is not engaged or retained to protect the Sovereign and Indefeasible rights of Irishmen and Irishwomen.
- Allodial/Lodial Interest:** The Highest Claim of Ownership of Private Property. Cannot be usurped by any other Legal of Lawful Claim.

- An Oifig Airgeadais:** The Office of Finance from the First Dáil Éireann 21st January 1919 with the relevant Seal of Office re-sanctioned on 5th July 2024 for utilisation under Oath by the appointed Secretary of the Department.
- An Oifig Chosanta:** The Office for Defence from the First Dáil Éireann 21st January 1919 with the relevant Seal of Office re-sanctioned on 5th July 2024 for utilisation under Oath by the appointed Secretary of the Department.
- An Oifig Gnóthaí Eachtracha:** The Office for Foreign Affairs from the First Dáil Éireann 21st January 1919 with the relevant Seal of Office re-sanctioned on 5th July 2024 for utilisation under Oath by the appointed Secretary of the Department.
- An Oifig Iascaigh:** The Office for Fisheries from the First Dáil Éireann 21st January 1919 with the relevant Seal of Office re-sanctioned on 5th July 2024 for utilisation under Oath by the appointed Secretary of the Department
- An Oifig Oideachais agus Gaeilge:** The Office for Education and Irish from the First Dáil Éireann 21st January 1919 with the relevant Seal of Office re-sanctioned on 5th July 2024 for utilisation under Oath by the appointed Secretary of the Department
- An Oifig Tailte agus Talmhaíochta:** The Office of Lands and Agriculture from the First Dáil Éireann 21st January 1919 with the relevant Seal of Office re-sanctioned on 5th July 2024 for utilisation under Oath by the appointed Secretary of the Department
- An Oifig Thionscail agus Tráchtála;** The Office of Industry and Commerce from the First Dáil Éireann 21st January 1919 with the relevant Seal of Office re-sanctioned on 5th July 2024 for utilisation under Oath by the appointed Secretary of the Department
- Beneficial Interest:** The Underlying Ownership of Private Property as can be separated from the Legal Estate/Interest by way of Private Trust of Land. Not to be confused with Usufruct Rights under Roman Civil Law.
- By-Laws:** The By-Laws for Antrim, Armagh, Carlow, Cavan, Clare, Cork, Derry, Donegal, Down, Dublin, Fermanagh, Galway, Kerry, Kildare, Kilkenny, Laois, Leitrim, Limerick, Longford, Louth, Mayo, Meath, Monaghan, Offaly, Roscommon, Sligo, Tipperary, Tyrone, Waterford, Westmeath, Wexford, & Wicklow recognising and enforcing the Sovereign and Indefeasible Rights of the People of Ireland.
- Citizen:** A Man or Woman's Identity, Corporate or Sovereign.
- Citizen of Ireland:** A Sovereign Man or Woman in Éire utilising their Identity.
- Citizen of Ireland Inc.:** A Person born or naturalised in the State subject to the Jurisdiction thereof. One who is below in position, inferior and subject to the control, authority, power and legal right of a State, subject to the administrative rules, regulations and ordinances of the State where rights are given by qualifications.

Citizen of Irish Republic: One who, under the Constitution is a Member of a Community, owing allegiance to, and being entitled to, religious and Civil Liberty, Equal Rights and Equal Opportunities, with Guarantee by Government.

Certificate of Citizenship: Certificates of Citizenship of the Irish Republic for Éire Sovereign Claimants.

Community Council: A Community Council established by/for a Community Region in Éire with IRB Acknowledgment and Support with an objective *“...to secure Sovereign People’s Rights for the Protection, Management and Development of their Community, in allegiance with the Will and Wish of the People of the Community, as the Sovereign Representatives for the Indigenous Community, and as Liaisons for the Community, with any Corporate Bodies making assumptions and/or presumptions in relation to the Development, Management and Protection of the Community Lands and Infrastructure”* among other objectives as agreed from time to time with the Members of the Community Council Co-Op for furtherance of the Manifesto of the Community Council.

Cymru: The Ancient Name for the Nation of Wales as chosen by the People of that Nation for defining their Territory Claim as part of the Albion Council Co-Op.

Cymru Council: The Council as established on 28th September 2024 in Llynmawr (Dolywern) LL20 7BB Wales Cymru with Manifesto and Code of Conduct for Members.

Cymru Council Co-Op: The Co-Op as established on 28th September 2024 in Llynmawr (Dolywern) LL20 7BB Wales Cymru.

Declaration of Birmingham: The Declaration by the Albion Council to the People of the Albion Region as Promulgated in Knowle, Solihull, Birmingham on 15th June 2024.

Declaration of Éire: The Declaration by the Éire Council to the People of Munster, Leinster, Ulster and Connaught, as Signed, Sealed and Promulgated in the Harbour Hotel, Galway, Éire on 5th April 2025 (Greg.)

Declaration of Independence: The Declaration of Independence of January 21st 1919 for Éire.

Declaration of Trust: The expansion of the 1916 Proclamation by way of Declaration of Trust 8th April 2022 with Affirmation & Expansion 11th September 2025 and continuing.

Deed of Acknowledgment and Confirmation: The Deed & Visible Vote of the Sovereign Claimant in the Albion Region signed and sealed by the Executive of the relevant Council.

Éire Community Council: The Council as established on 1st March 2025 (Greg.) in Ballinafad Sligo Éire with Manifesto & Code of Conduct.

Éire East: Carlow, Dublin, Kildare, Kilkenny, Laois, Longford, Louth, Meath, Offaly, Westmeath, Wexford and Wicklow

Éire North: Antrim, Armagh, Cavan, Derry, Donegal, Down, Fermanagh, Monaghan & Tyrone.

Éire South:	Clare, Cork, Kerry, Limerick, Tipperary & Waterford.
Éire West:	Galway, Leitrim, Mayo, Roscommon & Sligo.
E.I.R.E.ie	The Domain Name for the Enrolment of Irelands Real Estate for the Protection of Private Property in Éire on a Public Platform.
E.I.R.E.org	The Domain Name for the Enrolment of Internation Real Estate for the Protection of Private Property in the Albion Region on a Public Platform.
E.I.R.E.com	The Domain Name for the Enrolment of Indigenous Rights to evolve commerce for the Sovereign Nations of the World on a Public Platform.
Engleland:	The Ancient Name for Albion/England.
Engleland Council:	The Council as established in Ferrybridge, West Yorkshire on 27 th September 2024 with Manifesto and Code of Conduct for Members.
Engleland Council Co-Op:	The Co-Op as established in Ferrybridge, West Yorkshire on 27 th September 2024.
Equitable Interest:	The Underlying Ownership of Private Property (can be equal to but not greater than Beneficial Interest) as can be separated from the Legal Estate/Interest by way of Private Trust of Land. Not to be confused with Usufruct Rights under Roman Civil Law.
Executive:	The Executive of the Supreme Council of the Irish Republican Brotherhood, and other Councils in the Albion Region, that are in alignment with IRB/Éire position, consisting of the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary.
Exile:	A male or female irrespective of age separated from his or her Country or home involuntarily or by force of circumstances.
Faodhla:	The Protectors of Communities and Children.
Faodhla.ie:	The Domain Name for the records of all Community Councils in Éire.
Faodhla Féilre:	The 13-month calendar as adopted by the Éire Community Councils on 8 th January 2026.
Flag Charter:	The IRB Charter for the Flags of the Sovereign Nation State and Republic of Éire.
Independence Day:	January 21 st the Independence Day for the Sovereign Nation State of Éire and the Irish Republic.
Indigenous Irish:	Anyone born on the island of Ireland or born on any of the islands in the Sovereign Territory of Éire, whose ancestors were born in Ireland, or any of the islands in the Sovereign Territory of Éire, before January 21 st , 1919.

- IRB Bank:** The Bank established by the Department of Finance, the Department of Home Affairs and the National Economic Council, on 3rd November 2025, for the People of Ireland and the Éire Communities.
- I.R.B Executive Order 22-8-22:** Executive Order executed on 22nd June 2022 for the reversion of authority conditionally transferred to Dáil Éireann on 21st January 1919.
- I.R.B Executive Order 4291:** Executive Order executed on 28th July 2023 in furtherance of the duties of Dáil Éireann as provided for under I.R.B Executive Order 22-8-22.
- I.R.B Executive Order 1-3-25:** Executive Order executed on 1st March 2025 delegating Regional Powers of Governance of the Irish Republic to the Éire Community Council on condition of adherence and allegiance to the IRB Programme.
- I.R.B Executive Order 4-8-25:** Executive Order affirming the IRB Provincial Councils role of assistance for the establishment of the nuclei for all Community Councils in all Four Provinces of Éire.
- IRB Home Affairs:** The Political Wing of the IRB established in 1905 and Re-Established on 11th March 2026.
- IRB Provincial Councils:** The IRB Munster Council for Éire South, the IRB Leinster Council for Éire East, the IRB Connaught Council for Éire West and the IRB Ulster Council for Éire North, operating by the relevant Foregoing Constitutions in conjunction with IRB Affirmation & Confirmation 28th July 2025 (Greg.)
- Ireland:** The island of Ireland comprising Antrim, Armagh, Carlow, Cavan, Clare, Cork, Derry, Donegal, Down, Dublin, Fermanagh, Galway, Kerry, Kildare, Kilkenny, Laois, Leitrim, Limerick, Longford, Louth, Mayo, Meath, Monaghan, Offaly, Roscommon, Sligo, Tipperary, Tyrone, Waterford, Westmeath, Wexford, & Wicklow.
- Irish Free State:** Carlow, Cavan, Clare, Cork, Donegal, Dublin, Galway, Kerry, Kildare, Kilkenny, Laois, Leitrim, Limerick, Longford, Louth, Mayo, Meath, Monaghan, Offaly, Roscommon, Sligo, Tipperary, Waterford, Westmeath, Wexford & Wicklow as governed to date by Crown Corporations.
- Irish Republic:** The Sovereign Independent State inclusive of all land air and water and its natural assets and resources therein and thereof (also: **ÉiRE, éire, Éire, Éire,Ériu, Republic of Ireland, Éireann, Éirinn**) as Proclaimed in Arms on Easter Monday April 24th 1916 at 12:04pm Irish Rising Time.
- Irish Republican Brotherhood (IRB):** The Constitutional Organisation founded by James Stephens on March 17th 1858 that operates under its Foregoing Constitution.

Irish Rising Time:	From 12:04pm Easter Monday April 24 th 1916 with the Rights of the People of Ireland as Sovereign and Indefeasible and the ownership of Ireland for the People of Ireland Proclaimed by Patrick Pearse at GPO Dublin, and remote and independent from any other timeline, for any other Alien claim over Ireland and the Rights of the People of Ireland , it being unique, extant and continuing
Legal Interest:	The Legal Estate Ownership of Property assuming a Public Trust Interest and Usufruct Rights under Roman Civil Law.
Live Born Record:	The Live Born Record in Éire for the Sons and Daughters of the Men and Women
Óglaigh Gnóthaí Baile:	The Department of Home Affairs as established on 22 nd January 1919 and Re-Established under Óglaigh Command Call 101 on 3 RD May 2025.
Óglaigh na hÉireann:	The Organisation A.K.A The Irish Volunteers, (“ÓnahÉ”) founded as Defenders and Protectors for the Sovereign Nation and Territory, by the IRB in 1913, with First Constitution on 25 th October 1914, in response to the establishment of the Ulster Volunteers, with the First Constitution updated by IRB on 17 TH June 2023 (Greg.).
Oifig an Phoist agus Telegrafa:	The Office of Post and Telegraphs from the First Dáil Éireann 21 st January 1919 with the relevant Seal of Office re-sanctioned on 5 th July 2024 for utilisation under Oath by the appointed Secretary of the Department
Oifig an Uachtaráin:	The Office of President from the First Dáil Éireann 21 st January 1919 with the relevant Seal of Office re-sanctioned on 5 th July 2024 for utilisation under Oath by the appointed Secretary of the Department
Seal Charter:	The IRB Charter for the Seals of the Sovereign Republic of Éire.
Sovereign Citizen:	A dweller or inhabitant in a city, town or place, with the state of exemption from the control of another. One who enjoys liberty and is not subject to the will of another.
Sovereign Constitution:	The Constitution of the Republic of Ireland, proclaimed in arms on Easter Monday, April 24 th , 1916 at 12:04pm Irish Rising Time, and established by the Will of the People of Ireland, on January 21 st , 1919, advanced by Maire Nic Suibhne in January 1930 and printed in the United States of America for the Government of the Republic of Ireland and formally adopted by the IRB/ÓnahÉ Copy-Right Copy-Claim of 17 TH June 2023, advanced thereafter for Sovereign Claimants in Éire, with 1 st International Recognition of 11 th November 2023 and 2 nd & 3 rd International Recognition on 28 th September 2024, extant and continuing.
Sovereign Licence:	A Valid and Bona Fide Licence granted by the IRB subject to Terms of Usage for a calendar year up to January 20 th and which may be reissued on January 21 st subject to ongoing Terms of Usage.
Sovereign Seal:	Seals of the Sovereign Republic held In Trust for the People by IRB/ÓnahÉ

- Supreme Council:** The Governing Body of the Irish Republican Brotherhood.
- The Common Good:** Sovereign and Indefeasible Rights of Men and Women protected communally.
- The Dáil Éireann:** The Dáil established by the Will of the People of Ireland on 21st January 1919 and whose powers of governance of the Irish Republic were transferred from the IRB on condition that the Dáil follow the Programme of the Brotherhood to the full letter of the law with the licence for their operation being renewed each year on January 21st by the IRB with the Sovereign Seals of Office as sanctioned by the Sovereign President on 5th July 2024.
- The Dáil Éireann Courts:** The Courts established by the Will of the People of Ireland on 21st January 1919 to protect the rights of the Sovereign Man and Woman, under Customary/Common Law, Natural Law and/or The Brehon Laws, with the licence for their operation being renewed each year on January 21st by the IRB providing natural extension for the establishment of the Éire Community, County and Supreme Courts.
- The Great Seal:** The Great Seal of the Sovereign Nation State of Éire AKA the Éire Albion Seal entrusted to the Éire Community Council for use by the Executive thereof by the rules of the Manifesto with the endorsement of IRB Supreme Council and the Department of Home Affairs.
- The National Economic Council:** The Advisory Body for the Government of the Irish Republic with Delegates representative of the various industrial and economic interests in the Republic including but not limited to **Agriculture Forestry & Environment, Fisheries, Minerals & Mining, Manufacturing & Distributing** (of home produce) **Transport & Engineering** (including Highways, Railways, Canals, Shipping, Aviation) **Banking, The Gaedhealtacht, And Tourism, Arts & Cultural Heritage.**
- The People of Ireland:** The Sovereign Irishmen and Irishwomen.
- The Proclamation:** The Document entitled **POBLACHT NA H EIREANN THE PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT OF THE IRISH REPUBLIC OF IRELAND TO THE PEOPLE OF IRELAND** as promulgated by Patrick Pearse at 12:04pm IRT at the GPO Dublin on Easter Monday April 24th 1916 (Greg.) and said Document which **1)** Constitutes the Provisional Government, **2)** Declares the Rights of the People of Ireland to be Sovereign and Indefeasible, **3)** Declares, as Land Patent, the right of the People of Ireland to the ownership of Ireland, and is signed by 7 Members of the IRB Military/Supreme Council and remains under **IRISH REPUBLIC BROTHERHOOD COPYRIGHT COPY-CLAIM.**
- The Programme of the Brotherhood:** The IRB Programme with the Prerequisite Principles for governance of the Sovereign Republic of Éire.
- The President:** The President of the Irish Republican Brotherhood & The Irish Republic.
- The Tricolour:** The True Tricolour Flag of Green/White/Orange of the Sovereign Independent Nation State measuring 63" x 29.25 – 30" and held in Trust for the Sovereign Independent Nation State by the Irish Republican Brotherhood.

UN Declaration of Indigenous Rights: The United Nations Declaration of Indigenous Rights as adopted by the UN General Assembly on 13th December 2007.

UPU Flag Position: The Tricolour Flag of Green/White/Orange of the Sovereign Independent Nation State measuring 1.9" x 1" on document, salvaged from origin under the Hibernia Flag UPU Claim, and granted most of the same rights as the Title 4 Flag, and held in Trust for the Sovereign Independent Nation State by the Irish Republican Brotherhood.
