These minutes shall comprise the minutes of the National Economic Council and Irish Republican Brotherhood Supreme Council.

1. Money Bill 102 & Sovereign Minting

The council moved to fundamentally alter the Sovereign Nation's economic framework by shifting away from fiat dependency.

- **Money Bill 102 Framework:** This bill activates Article 9 of the IRB Bank Chapter and Covenant to transform the people's energy connection with fiat currency through a "Sovereign Mint".
- **Asset Backing:** The **Éire Meitheal Punt** is backed by the Life Force of the People of Ireland and shared ownership of "in-ground assets" (gold, silver, zinc, oil, and gas) of the Sovereign Territory of Éire.
- **Port Number:** A unique port number (**083 1731271**) was secured to facilitate the transfer of the 450,000 ÉMP to the Éire Treasury.

- **Bond Structure Details**

Original 7-bond process:

- Total: 177,000 ÉMP per Mint
- 9/10 to Community Treasury
- 1/10 to individual Sovereign Claimant

New 16-bond structure (Money Bill 102):

- Total: 450,000 ÉMP per mint
- Individual retains: 17,700 ÉMP
- Community treasury: ~158,000 ÉMP
- Éire Treasury: ~274,000 ÉMP (9 additional bonds)

- **Current minting status:** Over 50 million ÉMP minted across 115+ bonds, arising from additional 9 bonds from existing mints to be issued to Éire Treasury
- **Valuation Logic:** To ensure the currency is practical for daily use, the Council defined its value relative to silver. The Board unanimously decided and agreed that **10 Éire Meitheal Punts equal 1 ounce of silver.**
- **Three Components of ÉMP Value**
 1. **Bonds:** Paper position backed by authentic energy possessions
 2. **UPU Stamp:** Aligned with English pound or US dollar for app-based transfers
 3. **Asset Backed:** 10 ÉMP = 1 ounce of silver, tied to in-ground assets

2. Strategic Territorial & Legal/Lawful Defence and Constitutional Standing

A local Council Member from Connemara gathered 40+ signatures within 24 hours, targeting 100 signatures for Connemara North and 100 for Connemara South and potentially 300 total across Connemara North and South in due course.

- **Seaweed Harvesting Rights:** In Connemara, landowners are facing “attacks”. The initiative addresses Canadian company exploitation of seaweed harvesting rights under the **CETA agreement**, which remains pending in Ireland following a 2020-2022 Supreme Court challenge.
- **Strategic opportunity:** Approximately 50 landowners hold seashore rights with folios for seaweed harvesting. The Council can hold court once critical mass is reached to recognise Connemara as a unified region and expand Gaeltacht designation to full perimeter, protecting landowner rights.
- **Gaeltacht Expansion:** The council agreed to support communities wishing to extend Gaeltacht designations to the full perimeter of their community maps to provide a “unique opportunity” for protection of rights.

- **Fingal/Blanchardstown Concerns:** Discussion occurred regarding a zoning change and study area in **Dunsink**, with efforts to obtain records from Fingal County Council to monitor the potential assignment of foreign nationals to the area.
- **FOI Request Progress:** Information obtained for gold, silver, zinc, oil, and gas holdings across six Munster counties, now ported to IRB bank position as people's in-ground assets. Ulster, Connacht, and Leinster information to follow.
- **Manifesto signing:** National Economic Council manifesto completed with executive signatures and seals from Department of Finance, National Economic Council, and Office of the President.

3. Internal Protocols & Digital Integration

The council is professionalising its public image and refining its internal administrative requirements.

- **Signing Protocol:** For future minting, participants must sign the ledger using the **exact given name** as it appears on their **authentic birth certificate**. This is intended to "copper fasten" the alignment of the sovereign claimant.
- **Digital Infrastructure:** * The **Faodhla website** is being upgraded to serve as the primary repository for all IRB, National Economic Council, and Éire Court documents.
 - Past records from the IRB Supreme Council website (dating back up to four years and beyond) will be converted to PDFs and ported to the new site to ensure transparency.
- **The "Silent" Approach to Growth:** The Council resolved not to "go looking for people to help" as seeking out participants often has the "opposite effect". Instead, they will allow people to come forward voluntarily.

4. Governance and Transparency

- **Response to external criticism:** James Patrick Nestor sent what is likely a ChatGPT-generated critique questioning IRB operational position and execution. Council consensus: no engagement with attacks; maintain focus on transparent execution.

Transparency measures:

- All meeting minutes published publicly
- IRB content to be integrated into Faodhla website for clearer visibility
- Full adherence to constitutional process and code of conduct.
- **Organisational principle:** "If you wish to say, you must be willing to state" – members must commit time and documentation, not just observation.

5. Any Other Business

- **Westport 15-minute city concerns:** Cameras and UN Agenda 2030 sustainable goals observed; Council to monitor but not proactively engage until community raises formal concerns.
- **Blanchardstown/Fingal:** FOI request submitted to Fingal County Council for zoning change records on 1,000-acre study area (15,000 units for 50,000 foreign nationals). Community council intervention may be needed post-construction.
- **Organisational resilience:** Former members who deviated from documented processes caused significant harm to claimants now in 13th-hour crisis situations. Strict adherence to approved templates and transparency protocols emphasized and reinforced.
