Subject: International Protection Act 2026 (the "Proposed Legislation")

A Chara,

I write to you specifically in relation to the Communities of Finglas, Oughterard, Donegal Town, Ballyshannon, Crossmolina, Westport, Inishowen North, Inishowen South, Ballybofey, Glenties, Sligo Town, Letterkenny, Moycullen, Blessington, Castletroy, Blanchardstown and Ballyfermot-Castleknock; and more generally in relation to the other 211 Community Areas in Éire as recorded in www.faodhla.ie

I can confirm that none of these 228 Community Councils have expressed any wish to consent to the offer of the proposed legislation. To be clear, this means that the proposed legislation can hold no power or effect against the Rights of the Indigenous Sovereign Community Members of their Mapped Community Areas on www.faodhla.ie

The Sovereignty of the Nation of Éire is inalienable and remains intact with the People of Ireland as enshrined within the 1916 Proclamation and the Constitution of the Republic of Ireland.

The Éire Community Council(s) will be giving additional consideration to other proposed legislation in due course and will advise accordingly.
