1. General Conduct and Behaviour

- 1.1 Members of the Ballyshannon Community Council Co-Op ("the Organisation") are obliged to keep faith with the trust placed in them by their peers.
- 1.2 Core values such as impartiality integrity and respect are fundamental to the position of a Member of the Ballyshannon Community Co-Op Council.
- 1.3 Members must observe the highest ethical standards in their actions.
- 1.4 No Member of the Ballyshannon Community Co-Op Council will put personal opinion or gain above the Objectives of the Organisation as defined from time to time in the Manifesto of the Organisation.
- 1.5 Members accept that unity of the Council is of paramount importance and it is essential in order to achieve the Objectives of the Organisation and to deliver the Principles of the Manifesto.
- 1.6 Members will treat their colleagues and all Sovereign Men and Women with courtesy, respect and dignity.
- 1.7 Courtesy and respect will also be observed when using social media channels, messaging applications and written communications.
- 1.8 More generally, Members will at all times and in all matters seek to ensure that their conduct does not impugn the integrity of the Organisation
