5. Ballyshannon Community Co-Op Vocation

A side note in the 1919 Sovereign Constitution under the heading "**Vocational Councils**" reads as follows; *"There is a modern tendency to make the National Government arise out of Vocational Councils. It is a system which may be well worth considering for Ireland later on. For the present a central Government standing firmly for National Independence, and for an economic system suitable to the condition of the country, seems to be most desirable, and likely to command most confidence."*
